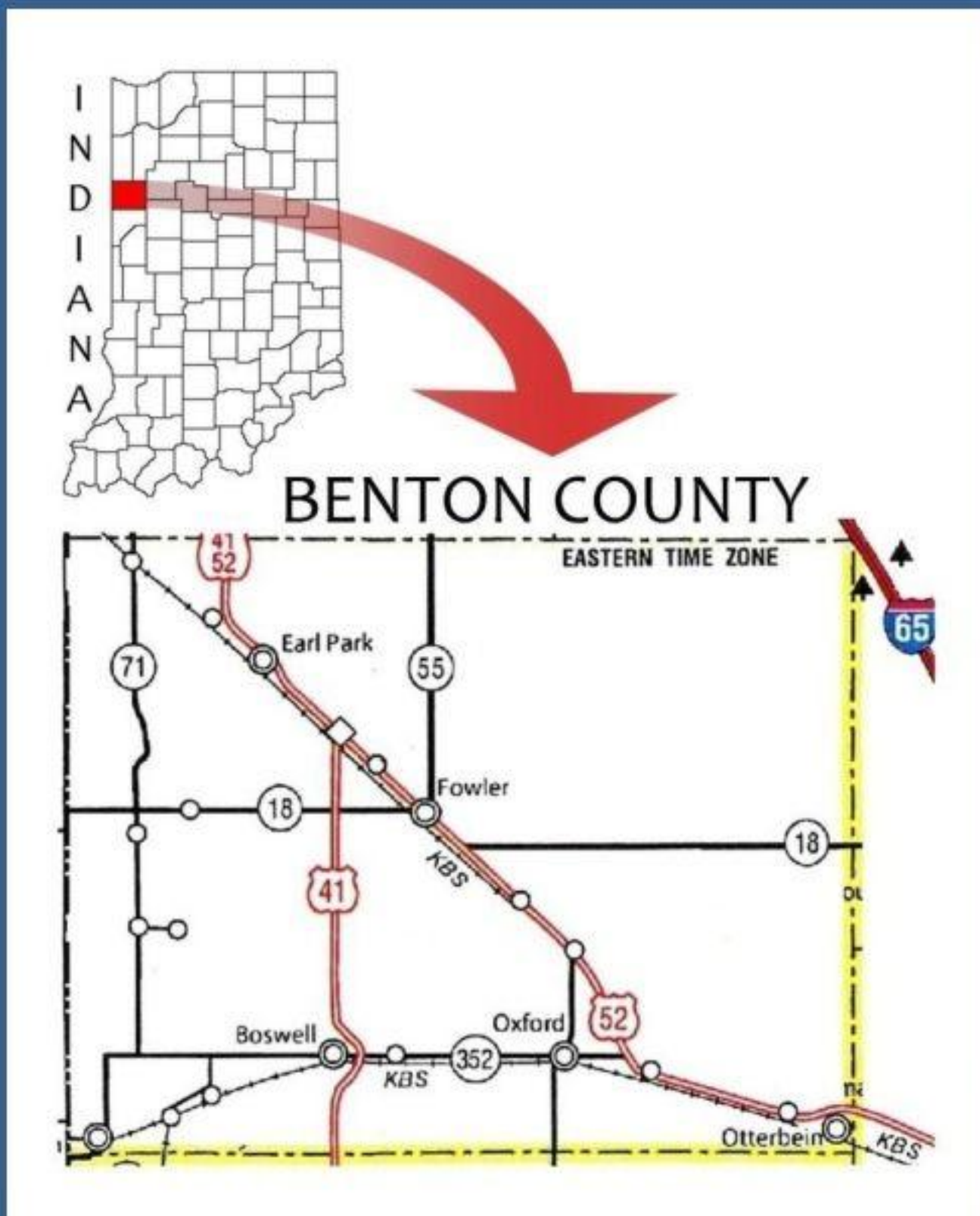


Where is Benton County?

Frequently Asked Questions

Q How long does a wind tour last?

A The length of a tour depends on the size, dynamics and time schedule of each group. Our tours typically last about two hours. At a minimum, your schedule should allow one and a half hours for a tour. However, if you have an extra-large group with many questions, tours may take longer.

Q How many people can go on the tour?

A We schedule tours for one to 75 persons.

Q What does the tour include?

A Our tours include a video presentation and a trip to a functional wind turbine. If your time schedule allows, you may also see and touch an actual wind turbine blade, witness a sub-station, and/or view two different types of wind turbines that are adjacent to each other. We make every attempt to be flexible so, if your group has a special need and/or agenda, please don't hesitate to let us know and we will work with you to make the best fit.

Q Where are the tours held?

A Our tours start at the Annex building, 410 S Adaway, Fowler In. 47944. After the video presentation you will be able to walk up and touch a blade on the ground at the Annex building. From there our tour guide will take you out to a functioning wind turbine, where you are able to view it from a 100 ft distance.
