Purpose of Research

Benton County Health Department would like to find out what you think about receiving care from a pediatric nurse practitioner who can provide well-child checks, sick visits, lab testing, and write prescriptions for children birth to 18 years old. Your feedback will be used to help the Health Department decide how to better meet your child's healthcare needs.

Specific Procedures and Duration of Participation

This interview is voluntary. It will take about 10 minutes to answer 12 questions. You may stop at any time, which will not affect the care that your child will receive at the Health Department.

Risks

The risks are minimal, no greater than everyday life. To reduce the possibility of breach of confidentiality (i.e., your name, phone number, child's name, and birth date), special procedures are in place and will be mentioned in the Confidentiality section.

Benefits

There is no direct benefit to the subjects for participation. You may experience indirect benefits if the Health Department decides to hire a pediatric nurse practitioner as a result of this study.


Compensation

Confidentiality

Your responses to interview questions will be recorded in an online form. Your personal information (e.g. your name, phone number, child's name, and birth date) will not be connected with your responses. Your personal information will be shredded at conclusion of the interview. Participants' responses will be analyzed and reported as a group. The research team (Dr. Karen Chang and Melinda Foley-Mink) will save anonymous responses in two secured servers indefinitely: one at the County Health Department for Melinda to access; one at Purdue University for Dr. Karen
