PROCEDURE FOR SEPTIC INSTALLATION

- 1) Come in or print an application online. Submit the application and pay the fee of \$50.00.
- 2) Contact one of the Soil Scientists on the attached page (or one of your choice that is APCPACS Certified Soil Science Consultants -- full list is available in my office.) The attached list is not a recommendation, but only a list of Soil Scientists in our area. The homeowner a copy and the Health Department a copy.
- 3) Upon receiving your copy, call to confirm that the Health Department has received their copy or stop by. We will then get a notice out to the Building Commissioner, Matt Hull, to complete a site check.
- 4) The proposed site should be marked and protect from machinery, buildings, etc. (shouldn't be disturbed, and Matt Hull will complete the site check. If approved, the permit will be issued at this time.
- 5) The installer shall call the Health Department for an inspection before covering the system. Try to give 24-hour notice so the Building Commissioner is available.
- 6) Do not disturb the ground until final inspection has taken place.

FINAL INSPECTION

GENERAL PLOT PLAN OF SITE AND SEPTIC SYSTEM AS INSTALLED

Include the following: (Give distances in feet - indicate north on drawing)

1. Locate house on drawing
2. Indicate property lines and any easements present
3. Indicate all wells on property and adjoining properties
4. Indicate location of old building foundations, structures, ponds, drainageways, swales, ditches and general direction of slope
5. Drawing of septic system itself to include:
 - A. Distance and direction from house to septic tank
 - B. Distance and direction from septic tank to diversion valves, distribution boxes and location and lengths of all solid delivery pipes
 - C. Location, width and depths of all trenches. Mark with "X" areas where trench bottom depths measured during inspection
