
The board reviewed and approved the following CF-1's returned with a motion by Councilman, Brent Cox, second by Councilman, Bruce Buchanan;


- Boswell Chase Grain (2)

- Jordan Creek Wind Farm LLC (2)



He then stated that there is a potential new wind farm coming to Richland and York Township, and Bolivar and Pine Townships. Councilman Buchanan asked how many towers it will bring – Steelhead will have about 45 and NextEra will have about 7-10 towers. They will add another 400 megs.


Commissioner Freeland gave an update on the County Home remodel. They just need to finish up a few things, the restroom and kitchen areas are not done. The septic will be placed this week.
