The Benton County Council met at 8:30 a.m. at the Benton County Courthouse. Those in attendance were Council members: Jim Schoen, Angie Glotzbach, Mike Conner, Jack Duncan, Jackie Steinmetz, Katrina Schutter and Chief Deputy Auditor, Beth Budreau

Business:

The meeting minutes from March 23, 2023, meeting was approved as presented with a motion by Councilwoman, Angie Glotzbach, seconded by Councilman, Mike Connor and motion carried.

The meeting minutes of 02.23.2023 were resigned by the council members.

Councilman Jim Schoen talked about the two transfers of monies that were being requested. \$1,113.39 in the Reassessment Fund – from the Contractual Services account line to the Aerial Photography account line per the Assessors office. Also, a request from the Treasurer's office – from the clerical account line to the Envelope account line in the amount of \$1000.00. Councilwoman, Angie Glotzbach presented with a motion to approve the transfers, seconded by Councilman Jack Duncan and motion carried.

Councilwoman Angie Glotzbach wanted to make the other council members aware that the Treasurer is transferring out of clerical this time, but clerical is normally the line item needing more money for part-time help towards the end of the year.

Councilwoman Jackie Steinmetz asked about a rumor that she heard about the County Commissioners purchasing a church, she wanted to know if that was true. Councilman Jim Schoen stated that it was true, but he believes grant money will be reimbursing them. Deputy Auditor Beth Budreau stated from her understanding it is state funded grant money that has/will be applied for, regarding childcare.

Councilman Schoen stated that the grant was going to expire before the deed could be processed. So, the commissioners purchased the old presbyterian church and then the grant money will reimburse them. Councilwoman Jackie Steinmetz asked if the commissioners moved money around of where they got the money to purchase the church. Councilman Schoen said he is guessing they used wind money and then they will put it back once they are reimbursed.


With no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:36 a.m. with a motion by Councilman Jack Duncan, second by Councilwoman, Trina Schutter, motion carried.




